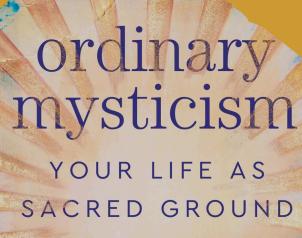

This 7-week study is based on *Ordinary Mysticism:* Your Life as Sacred Ground by

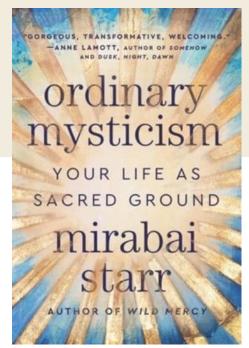
Mirabai Starr.

Participant's Guide

We are gathered for the 2025 Fall Study Series, "Ordinary Mysticism," with the shared intention of deepening our spiritual journey.

Our purpose is to cultivate connection with one another, our authentic Self, and the Divine. Through study, reflection, and sharing, we encourage and inspire each other to grow spiritually, to build meaningful connections, and to experience joy in the process.

Guided by divine love and infinite wisdom, we honor the sacredness of our time together as we explore the mystical presence in ordinary life.

Sacred Agreements

- Encourage authentic sharing and honor diverse perspectives.
 - Maintain confidentiality What is shared here, stays here.
 - Take responsibility for the energy I bring.
 - Practice compassionate listening and speaking.
- Refrain from criticism, judgment, advice-giving, interrupting, or fixing.
 - Honor both laughter and tears.
- Be mindful of how much and often I talk, allowing space for others.
 - Use centering words or phrases to return to topic.

(i.e. "Let's reboot... or Let's return to the topic.")

- Start and end on time.
- Notify host if unable to attend.
- Refrain from advertising, promoting, or soliciting.
 - Have fun!

We also agree to honor the host(s) home by leaving promptly after the book study is over.

Book Group - Weekly Format & Flow



Opening Prayer – Acknowledge Spirit's presence.

Consider sharing the role of opening prayer by reading or saying a prayer.



Check-In Round (2 -3 minutes per person)

- Share one thing you're grateful for today. OR
- Share a positive insight from this week. OR
- Share something that made an "Ordinary Mysticism" impact this week. OR
- Share an aha from last week's homework assignment.



Discussion / Study Questions (50ish minutes)

Each week, study questions will be provided. During discussion, aim for a balanced conversation where everyone has the chance to contribute - or pass if they prefer. Cover as many questions as time allows, focusing on thoughtful dialogue rather than rushing through.



Wrap-Up (2-3 minutes per person) – In closing, take time to share any prayer requests. Then, in a final circle, each participant is invited to reflect by completing the phrase: "One thing I'm taking with me from today's gathering is..."
